The FCFPA is a regional community foundation, serving donors and affiliates in Central and Northcentral Pennsylvania.

Union County Community Foundation (2005)

The FCFPA is a nonprofit, 501(c)(3) organization; gifts made to the Foundation are tax-deductible to the fullest extent allowed by law.

The FCFPA's founding affiliate, the Williamsport-Lycoming Community Foundation was the first foundation created in Pennsylvania.

The FCFPA is a member of the Council of Foundations (COF), and has been confirmed in compliance with national standards put forth by the COF (www.cof.org). This allows the Foundation to use the national standards seal of compliance.
