

THE DANIEL G. AND HELEN I. FULTZ SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Application Guidelines

Mr. Fultz was born and raised in Mifflin County and graduated from Burnham High School in 1950. He began his career at Lycoming College immediately following graduation in 1957. After 8 years at Lycoming College, his career took him to Wells College, then eventually on to Schlegel Manufacturing Company. In 1989, he retired from Schlegel Manufacturing and became the Treasurer of Lycoming College until his retirement.

Purpose & Eligibility: One scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school senior from Indian Valley High School in Mifflin County who has been accepted into a full-time undergraduate degree program at Lycoming College, Williamsport, PA. If there are no applicants from Indian Valley High School, then an applicant may be chosen from Lewistown High School in Mifflin County, again, who has been accepted into a full-time undergraduate degree program at Lycoming College, Williamsport, PA.

Application Process: An application with these guidelines can be obtained from the Indian Valley High School Guidance Office, Lewistown High School Guidance Office or by calling the Williamsport Lycoming Community Foundation at 866-901-2372.

- Submit a completed application form;
- Attach a cover letter not to exceed two pages outlining why he or she is applying for the scholarship and summarizing his/her ultimate career objectives;
- Provide proof that he or she has been accepted into a full-time undergraduate degree program at Lycoming College;
- Provide at least one letter of reference.

Application Deadline: Applications and requested materials must be returned to the Guidance Office no later than **April 15**.

Scholarship Selection Process: The Scholarship Selection Committee of the Indian Valley High School District (or in years where eligible, Lewistown High School) will select the recipient.

Complete Criteria:

- Recipient will be a graduating senior from the Indian Valley High School who has been accepted into a full-time undergraduate Program at Lycoming College, Williamsport, PA. If there are no applicants from Indian Valley High School, then applicants may be chosen from Lewistown High School in Mifflin County, again, who has been accepted into a full-time undergraduate degree program at Lycoming College, Williamsport, PA.
- Recipient will have exhibited good citizenship and community involvement, be a leader with a sense of humor, be grounded, show tolerance of others, is honest, has integrity, and makes a difference in the school community.
- Recipient will also have an unmet financial need.
- Other than a strong potential for success, such factors as class rank and grade point average will not be criteria in making a selection unless in the judgment of the selection committee such factors are needed to distinguish between multiple potential candidates.

Scholarship Awards: One scholarship will be awarded for 4 (four) years and equal to ¼ (25%) of the available income for each respective year. Each recipient must continue to be a student in good standing at Lycoming College. Scholarship payment will be paid directly to Lycoming College.
